

Contact Lens Wearing Agreement

We are committed to providing our patients with the best possible care. Fitting contact lenses is a procedure unique to everyone and there is no guarantee that every patient will be a successful contact lens wearer.

Our office charges a fee in addition to the comprehensive exam in order to fit and evaluate contacts because it is a separate procedure. The fees range depending on difficulty of fitting and our staff is available to discuss these fees once we know what the process will involve.

There is a separate fee to have your contact lens prescription renewed yearly because it requires additional testing which is not part of our standard exam.

The fitting cost covers all follow-ups and sample contact lenses for three months after the initial exam. ***It is your responsibility to keep your appointments in order to ensure that the fitting process is completed in a timely manner.*** Sample contact lenses are provided for fitting purposes only and you will be charged for any replacements needed due to neglect. There will be fees for each follow-up visit extending beyond the 3-month fitting period.

Training for new contact wearers is provided on how to insert and remove the lenses, along with cleaning and care instructions. If you are experiencing bothersome symptoms while wearing your lenses such as blurred vision, pain/discomfort, redness, or sensitivity to light, remove the lenses and call our office immediately.

We recommend that all contact lens patients have a set of glasses with your current prescription, and also sunglasses to protect your eyes against harmful UV light – and we offer 20% off eyewear to our contact lens wearers.
